First, I need to express our appreciation to Frank Bower for his outstanding demonstration on hollow form turning. It seems every turner who enjoys hollow form turning has his own unique way of doing what is essentially the same thing. What is true is that every one of us has accumulated every tool available, has tried every tool available and inevitably settles on the first hollowing tool we learned to use. I don't know why that is but it is consistently true. I talked with Frank and like me he has a drawer full of tools he's tried yet still returns to a choice few. I love to buy and try new toys but when I have a project on the lathe I will always reach for the tool I am comfortable with and know will help me achieve the result I want.

This month we will be returning to a club favorite - the round robin. There will be six lathes set up with different demos at each lathe. I'm not sure what every demonstrator will be doing but the variety will insure that just about all interests will be covered. Several months ago I was asked about thread chasing and I thought this would be a good demo to include. I have the tools, know how it's done and will share what I know. It's really easy and not nearly as intimidating as people think. Ideally dense hard woods such as boxwood or African blackwood are the materials of choice. In our days, fake ivory or corian are choice materials but almost any good tight grained hardwood will work. I learned a trick from Mark St Leger that works great for practicing – Schedule 40 PVC. I'll show you what I know and bring enough for material for everyone to give it a try. I'm not sure what else will be available but suspect pens, tops, ornaments and or



finials may be on the agenda. In past years, members sometimes brought stuff they wanted to sell or trade so that's also a possibility. This is a members' day event and I hope everyone will come and have a good time. Sean Mc Curley is organizing the event and feel sure he has selected and interesting variety of demos.

2012 is AWA's fifteenth year in operation and we've come a long way since our days in the back of Birmingham Saw Works warehouse where Nelson Brooks would threaten to sing if people didn't settle down so the meeting could get started. We've grown from the forty or so charter members to over one hundred twenty five or so members and represent every level of achievement from beginner to professional . 
